Assuming you are not transiting in China <72 hours, almost all travelers need a visa to go to China.

Traveling to Macau?

Do I need a visa to go to Macau?
Most passport holders from US, UK, EU, Australia, New Zealand do not need a visa for 7-day visits.

Do I need Macau money?
Business in Macau generally takes Hong Kong currency and assume a 1:1 exchange rate. So it is OK to use HKD in Macau.

HK Weather Signals

- Tropical cyclone warning signals explained:
- T1** Standby - A tropical cyclone is centred within 300 km of Hong Kong.
 - L3** Strong Wind - Strong winds are expected or blowing generally near sea level.
 - 8 or higher** Storm - Government, schools, private sector & transportation shuts down.

- Heavy rain warning signals explained:
- Amber** - Heavy rain has fallen or is expected to fall generally over HK. Bring umbrella.
 - Red** - Heavy rain has fallen, exceeding 50 mm/hour, and is likely to continue. Students stay home.
 - Black** - Very heavy rain has fallen, exceeding 70 mm/hour. Gov't, private sector & transportation shuts down.
